Christopher Waller joined the Federal Reserve Board of Governors in 2020, after serving as Executive Vice President and Director of Research at the St. Louis Fed for 11 years.

Prior to his work with the Fed, Dr. Waller served as the Gilbert Schaefer Chair of Economics at the University of Notre Dame, and Research Fellow at Notre Dame's Kellogg Institute for International Studies. From 1998 to 2003, he was the Carol Martin Gatton Chair of Macroeconomics and Monetary Economics at the University of Kentucky. During that time, he was also Research Fellow at the Center for European Integration Studies at the University of Bonn. From 1992 to 1994, he served as Professor of Economics at Indiana University.

Dr. Waller received a B.S. in economics from Bemidji State University, and an M.A. and Ph.D. from Washington State University.
